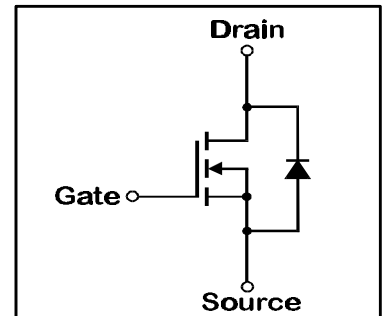

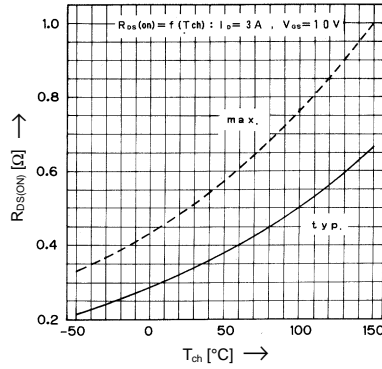

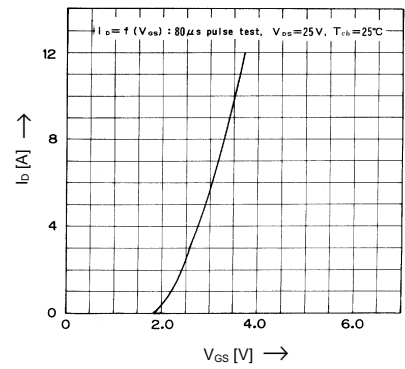
Typical Output Characteristics



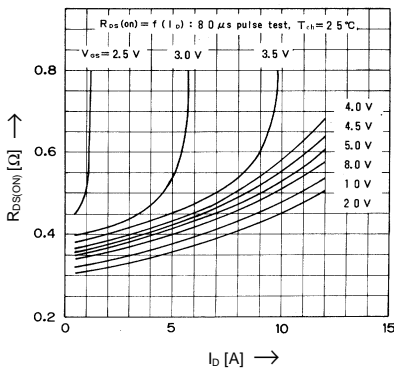
Drain-Source-On-State Resistance vs.  $T_{ch}$



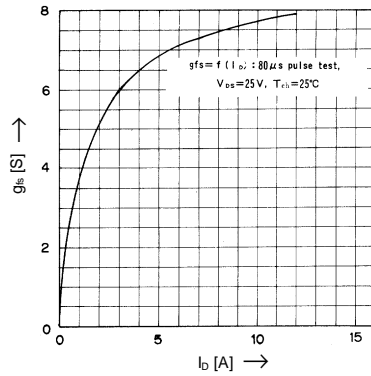
Typical Transfer Characteristics



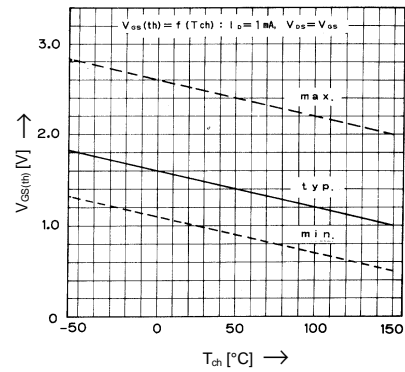
Typical Drain-Source-On-State-Resistance vs.  $I_D$



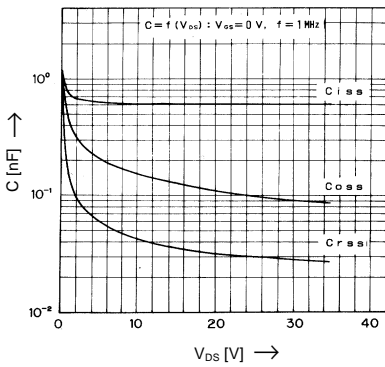
Typical Forward Transconductance vs.  $I_D$



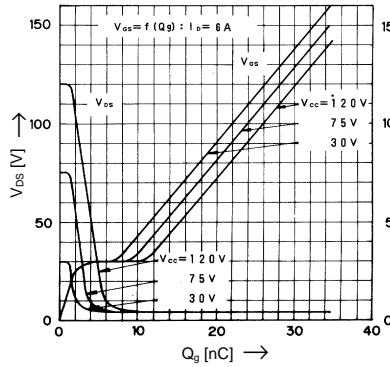
Gate Threshold Voltage vs.  $T_{ch}$



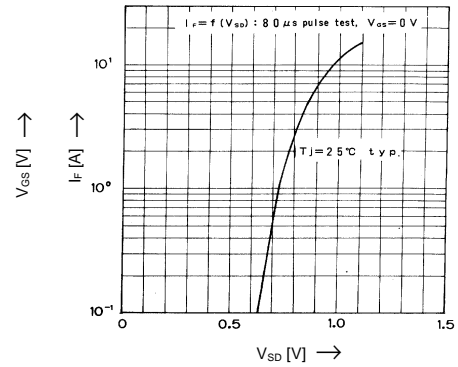
Typical Capacitance vs.  $V_{DS}$



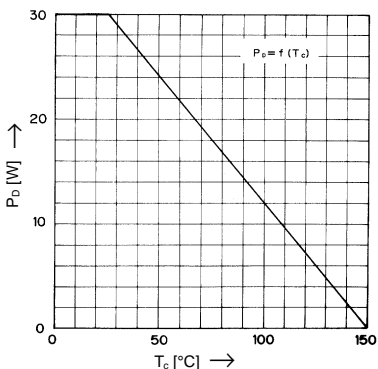
Typical Input Charge



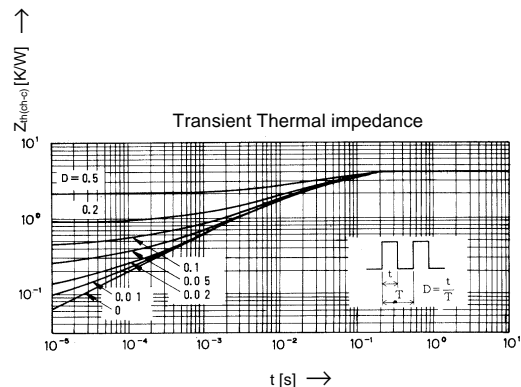
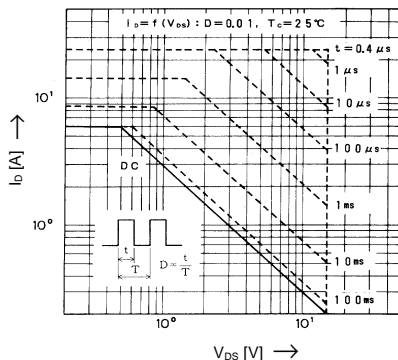
Forward Characteristics of Reverse Diode
